

SPILL CONTROL

Major Spillage

Clear the area and notify one of the following people

 - Jim Silver (Chemical Mixer)
 - Dean Joyce (Chemical Mixer)
 - Aaron Foster (Material Handler)
 - Sharon Osborn (Chemical Mixer)
 - Maciej Radzikowski (Material Handler)
1. Restrict Access – clear staff from the area and restrict access using barrier tape, notice, verbal instructions
 2. Use Personal Protection - Gloves, safety Glasses etc.
 3. Stop Leak – Stop or restrict leaking container where possible (turn off pumps or valves)
 4. Spill Kit - Use the spill kit in the Yellow containers
 5. Contain - The Socks/booms are used to contain and soak-up the liquid
 6. If Outside – Cover drain lids marked blue using drain covers in spill kit. Turn off pump for pit
 7. Clean Up - The absorbent granules, pads and mops are used to soak up liquid
 8. Dispose – The Bags in the spill kits are to be used
 9. Report Incident – and fill Spill Incident Record and hand in to H&S/QSHE

Minor Spillage

Minor spills must be cleared ASAP. Always use drip trays where possible,

1. Use Personal Protection - Gloves, safety Glasses etc.
2. Stop Leak – Stop or restrict leaking container where possible and safe to do so.
3. Display Warning Signs – Wet Floor
4. Clean Up – Using pads and Mops
