

## District By Election Glen Ward Wednesday 19th March 2025

An election will take place on Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> March in the Glen Ward of Harborough District Council. Information regarding key dates and events are shown below. Please note this election is being held on a Wednesday rather than the normal Thursday poll.

**Standing as a Candidate** – if you would like to stand as a candidate in this election, nomination packs will be available from Monday 10<sup>th</sup> February from the Council Offices in Market Harborough. Completed packs must be returned between Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> February & 4pm on Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> February only. An informal check is offered for candidates completed packs, this service is by appointment only, please see contact details below.

**Candidate Information** – we will publish a statement of persons nominated on Friday 21<sup>st</sup> February on our website and notice board.

**Registering to vote** –to register to vote in this election you must do so by Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> March. You can register online at www.gov.uk/register-to-vote if you need help to register please contact the Electoral Services Team using the contact details below.

**Applying for a postal vote** – If you would like to apply to vote by post in this election you must do so by 5pm on Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> March. You can apply online at **www.gov.uk/apply-postal-vote** if you need help to apply please contact the Electoral Services Team using the contact details below.

**Applying for a Proxy vote** – If you would like someone to vote on your behalf in this election you can apply for a proxy vote, you must do so by 5pm Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> March. You can apply online at **www.gov.uk/apply-proxy-vote** if you need help to apply please contact the Electoral Services Team using the contact details below.
