It details our vision and framework to guide development within the district for the period between 2020 and 2041. It sets out a strategy for the amount, location and design of development (such as homes, employment and other development needs including infrastructure) in a way that helps to ensure the vitality of communities, protect the district's rural character and unique built and natural heritage, as well as improve the natural environment and tackle climate change.

Representations are invited on the Draft Local Plan and associated documents between **9am on Monday 10 March and 9am on Tuesday 6 May 2025**. No representations will be accepted outside of this period.

Notification of the next steps

Once the consultation closes, all representations received will be submitted to the Secretary of State, who will appoint an Inspector to carry out an independent examination of the Local Plan. We are expecting submission to be later in 2025. At the examination, the Planning Inspector(s) will consider all representations received at Regulation 19 stage and examine the Plan, the evidence supporting it and make a decision whether it is sound and meets the legal requirements. It is anticipated that the Plan will be adopted before December 2026, at which point it will supersede the existing Harborough Local Plan 2011-2031.

Updates regarding the status of the Local Plan will be published on the Council's planning policy webpages. Any person who makes a submission during the Regulation 19 representation period will automatically be added to the Council's Local Plan consultation database and will be provided with updates on the progress of the Local Plan including when we submit our Local Plan for independent Examination, when the Planning Inspector's recommendations are published and when the Local Plan is adopted.
